## Proposal Writing Workshop

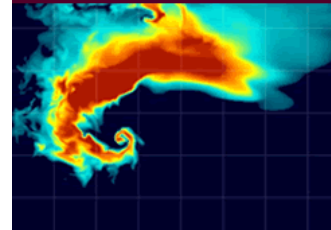
**Dec 15-17:** 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. daily, Room 301 Grawn Hall
