BEFORE MAILING YOUR APPLICATION:

1. Be sure to complete all sections and sign the application form. Unsigned applications cannot be processed.
2. Include your check or money order or provide credit card information for the \$35 non-refundable application fee. Make your check or money order payable to Central Michigan University.*
3. If born outside of the U.S., you must provide proof of U.S. citizenship (copies of immigrant visa, resident alien card, naturalization papers or passport).
4. Be sure to attach your response to item #26.
5. Some graduate programs require supplementary application materials and some have application deadlines. Contact your department at CMU and the *Graduate Bulletin* for additional requirements and/or materials, and for information on application deadlines.

ARRANGE FOR THE FOLLOWING TO BE SENT TO THE COLLEGE OF GRADUATE STUDIES:

1. One official copy of all undergraduate and graduate transcripts. Ask the registrar of each college or university attended (except CMU) to send these materials to the College of Graduate Studies. Copies issued to students are unacceptable. NOTE: Non-degree students may register for classes ONCE while CMU is waiting for their transcripts to arrive. Transcripts must be received prior to second registration.
2. If your program requires the GRE, GMAT or MAT, arrange to have an official copy of your scores sent directly to the College of Graduate Studies.

NOTE: If you are applying for a degree program that does not have an application deadline, you can expect to receive an admission decision about six weeks AFTER all your materials are received. Applications for non-degree status are processed more quickly.

* The application fee is waived only for McNair applicants and those applicants going from non-degree status to certificate or degree seeking status, or vice versa. The fee is required of all other applicants, including those who have earned graduate certificates or degrees and are applying to different graduate programs, and those who were previously denied admission and are reapplying to graduate programs.
